1. Term of Partnership

- All partnerships must be confirmed in writing via email or signed agreement.
- A partnership is only considered secure once a formal confirmation and payment have been received.
- Industry Partnership will be up to 31st December 2026.

2. Deposit & Payment Terms

- Full payment is due within 30 days of booking confirmation to guarantee the Introductory Rate, unless otherwise agreed with ACPME.
- Late payments may incur a 5% surcharge unless otherwise agreed.

3. Partnership Deliverables

- On receipt of booking confirmation ACPME will provide access and instructions to the Members Forum.
- Industry Partners are responsible for maintaining their own page on the Members Forum.

4. Use of Branding

- ACPME Industry Partnership logos, trademarks, and promotional content will be provided for use on Industry Partners own social media channels.
- Unauthorised use of branding may result in termination of the agreement.

5. Members Forum

- In the event of the Members Forum being unavailable (e.g., software outage, hardware malfunction, internet disruption), both parties agree to:
 - Notify the other party immediately.
 - Make reasonable efforts to resolve the issue or provide alternative solutions.
 - Reassess timelines and deliverables if the failure significantly impacts the partnership.
- Neither party shall be held liable for delays or losses caused by unforeseen technical issues, provided reasonable mitigation efforts are made.
